What do you want to explore or emphasize in this scene? Are you going for seductive? Stern? Teasing? Ritualistic? Just pick one. You don't need to shape shift into every fantasy he's ever had. Start with the energy that feels most natural to you.

Set the Stage	
 [] Do you wish to dim the lights or light a candle? [] Do you want to have music that makes you feel confident? [] Do want to have an outfit that makes you feel sexy or comfortable? [] Put him somewhere specific—kneeling, standing, waiting naked in bed? 	
You're not decorating a dungeon. You're setting a mood the YOU feel good in.

[] Did you ask for consent? Yes is the only answer! This can be as simple as to are you ok with this? the idea is no suprises, that way you have full consent. Consent.	•
Power Ritual or Entry Phrase	
How will you begin the scene? (e.g., command or ritual) Try One Ritual or Task Choose one simple act that defines the scene:	
 Inspecting him while he kneels Giving him a task (like kissing your feet or folding laundry at your feet) Letting him beg to kiss your hand or thigh 	
This is where the dynamic becomes real. He serves. You receive.

Use Simple Language pick three things you plan to say?

You don't need to sound like a movie Domme. Start with basic commands:

- · "Kneel."
- "Don't speak unless I ask you a question."
- "Keep your hands at your sides and your eyes down."

Say them slowly. Pause. Let the silence feel powerful. You are the Domme!

Scene Flow

What actions or dynamics will you explore? Remember to keep it simple, shorter is often better. General outline of actions in order

Close with a Ritual

Let the scene end clearly. A soft touch, a word like "we're done," or a cuddle if that's your vibe. Transitioning out of Domme mode helps both of you return to connection and care. You might like to use this everytime and create what are called protocols.
