Your personal guide to planning and running your first Femdom roleplay scene

1. Scene Title / Theme

What's the overall vibe?

Examples: Strict Headmistress, Goddess Worship, The Elegant Dinner, Lazy Afternoon Control.

2. Goal / Intention for the Scene

What do you want to explore or feel in this roleplay?

Examples: Practice giving commands, Enjoy ritualized service, Test restraint play.

3. Setting

Where will the scene happen? How will the environment look/feel?

Examples: dim lighting, background music, chair as “throne,” candles, leather gloves, etc.

4. Roles

Domme (You): How do you want to present yourself? (Tone, posture, outfit)

Sub: How should he behave? (Kneeling, waiting for permission, silent until spoken to, etc.)

5. Ritual / Scene Start

How will you begin?

Examples:

- Have him kneel and wait until you acknowledge him
- Give a greeting that sets the tone (“You may enter when I say so...”)
- Make him recite a mantra or kiss your hand

6. Main Actions / Flow

Write 3-5 actions or commands you want to include.

Examples:

- Command him to remove clothing slowly
- Direct him to perform a service (massage, foot rub, tea service)
- Control his posture or movement
- Use denial ("Not yet...")

Examples:

- "You exist to serve me."
- "Stay still. I'm not finished with you yet."

Examples:

- Give permission to speak/move

- Have him thank you and leave the space respectfully
